CAMP STAFF

The director of the Lady Lion Basketball Camp is coach Dale Neal, who has guided the Freed-Hardeman University Lady Lions to 13 consecutive NAIA National Tournament appearances, including three Elite Eights and two Final Fours.

During Neal's 15 seasons at FHU, the Lady Lions have an overall record of 390-135. This winning tradition has resulted in the Lady Lions' consistent ranking among the nation's elite in the NAIA polls.

The Lady Lions have posted four consecutive 30-win seasons as well as consistent top five NAIA national rankings. Neal was named the TranSouth Coach of the Year four consecutive years while leading the Lady Lions to three consecutive TranSouth Athletic Conference championships.

Neal's camps are renowned for their detailed fundamental instruction and for the individualized attention that each camper receives. Prominent area high school coaches will assist with the camp instruction. FHU assistant coach Lain Hinson and the Lady Lion basketball players will also be on hand to assist with the camp activities. University of Memphis Hall of Famer Don Holcomb will be on site to work with campers on post-play.



ELIGIBILITY

Dale Neal's Lady Lion Basketball Camp is for girls interested in developing and strengthening their individual basketball skills. Girls should be in grades four through 12. Campers will be grouped according to age and skill level. Skills will be taught in practice-session format based on skills needed for each age group.

Camp size is limited to ensure that each camper will receive the proper amount of individual instruction.
